

## Guideline Halo fly reels - change of retrieve.

The Halo fly reel are always delivered with a left hand retrieve, but can easily be changed to right hand retrieve. Please note that the bigger reels have a slightly different look inside the reel house, but the principal for retrieve change is the same. When we refer to the small reels we mean the 23, 45 & 67 models.

## Here we go:

- Unscrew the spool cap and take away the spool from the frame of the reel and put it aside.
- Unscrew the chrome colored brake housing. Here is the biggest difference between the big and small reels on the smaller reels (images below) you unscrew the hole housing, on the bigger reels you only unscrew the top.



 When you lift the brake housning you will now see the one-way bearing, BUT depending on the amount of grease inside the housning it can ither sit inside the brake housning (the part the hand is holding in the image), or inside the drag spindel in the bottom of the reel frame (the part in the centre of the reel frame).

In the image below you see the hexagon one-way bearing inside the drag spindel in the center of the reel frame.

 No matter where the one-way bearing sits, you now take a thin object like a needle or thin wire, lift the bearing up and put it back upside-down in the same place.



- Finally remount the brake housning firmly and attach the spool to the frame. Your reel is now ready with the retrieve changed.
